Mr. Gerald Wade Merritt, 93, passed away on Tuesday, September 8, 2020. Funeral services will be conducted at 3 PM on Saturday, September 12, 2020 in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville. Burial will be at the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Milledgeville.

Visitation will be from 2 PM until the Funeral Hour on Saturday.

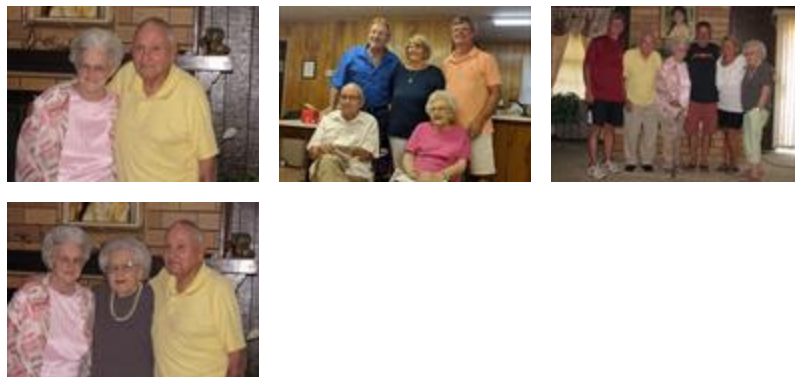
