Thanks a million for all of your love and kindness.

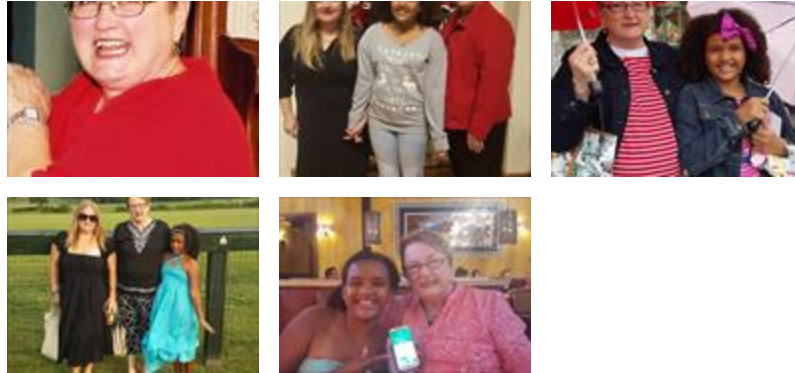
