Glenda Fay Roberson McCoy, age 76, of Gordon, passed away Monday, July 17, 2023. Funeral services for Glenda Fay McCoy will be conducted Thursday, July 20, 2023 at 2:00 pm in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville. Interment will be privately held in the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Milledgeville. 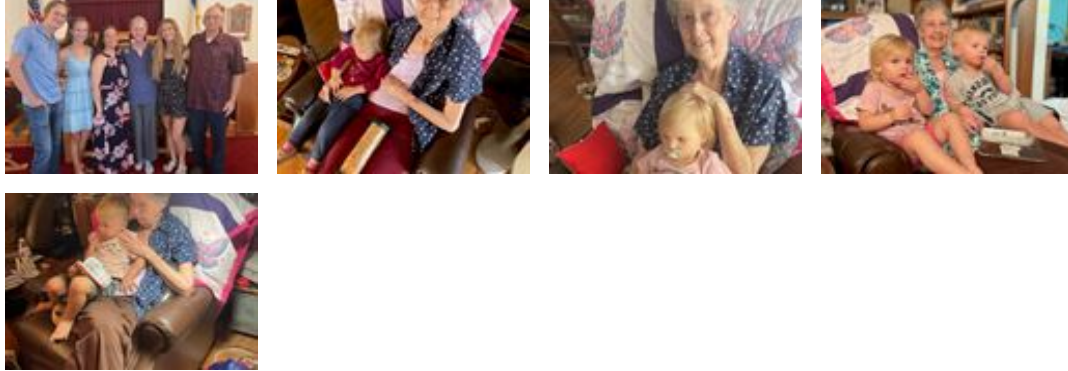
