Mr. Grady Brumbalow, age 78, passed away Tuesday, February 4, 2014. Funeral Services will be conducted Friday, February 7, 2014 at 11AM in Williams Funeral Home Chapel. Interment will follow in the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery.

The family will be at the funeral home Thursday Evening from 6-8PM to receive friends.
