



Gussie Dominy Eubanks

February 18, 1934 - May 19, 2024

Mrs. Gussie Dominy Eubanks, age 90, of Macon, passed away peacefully on May 19, 2024.

Funeral services for Gussie Eubanks will be conducted Saturday, May 25, 2024 at 11:00 AM in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home with Capt. Caleb Dunnam officiating. Interment will be private. The family will receive friends at the Williams Funeral Home on Saturday, May 25, 2024 from 10:00 AM until the service hour.

A native of Nickelsville, Georgia, Gussie also resided in Fort Valley, Warner Robins, Milledgeville, and Macon, GA. She was born on February 18, 1934 to the late Alton Bee Dominy and the late Rosa Lee Martin Dominy. Gussie was a retired Civil Service employee of Warner Robins Air Force Base and a member of Green Acres Baptist Church, Warner Robins, GA, and in later years, when she was unable to attend, enjoyed watching Ingleside Baptist Church from home. Her favorite activities were spending time in her flower garden and cooking for and spending time with family. She loved to laugh, especially with her four sisters, and loved sweet tea. Most recently, when she was unable to be outdoors much, she loved listening to music and keeping a diary of the various songs and artists and singing along. She spent many hours praying for family and friends. Gussie was known for her laugh, her sense of humor, and her very generous heart. Gussie loved Jesus and demonstrated her faith, first to her two daughters, involving them in church and loving them like Jesus loves. These daughters grew into faiths of their own. They found Christ follower husbands and continued their pursuits of Jesus. The tree grew with eight grandchildren, each one being shown the love of Jesus from an early age and each adopting a faith in Jesus of their own. With faith as her legacy, God was faithful to show up in the lives of those coming after her. The legacy now continues into a fourth generation with great grandchildren who are being raised in homes where they are loved well and will know that Jesus loves them from their earliest memories. The legacy of faith that Gussie passed to her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren is not something that was kept insular. Rather, this legacy has been passed on and on. And even though Gussie never lived outside of Georgia herself - the legacy of faith that she was faithful to pass on has been carried by her children and grandchildren to the nations, including countries from every continent except Antarctica. From North America, South America, Asia, Europe, Australia, Africa and beyond - it is impossible to know the full impact that Jesus has had on this world through Gussie's legacy.

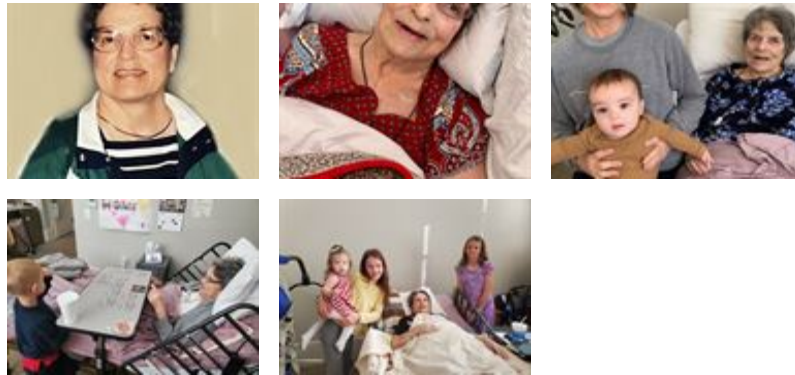

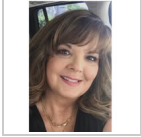
