Mr. Harrold Queen, age 77, passed away on Friday, September 1, 2017. A funeral service will be held on Wednesday, September 6 at 11am at Lake Country Baptist Church in Eatonton, with Dr. Carlisle Driggers officiating. Interment will follow at Oak Hill Cemetery in Griffin.
