Harry Truman Mercer, age 75, of Milledgeville, passed away Monday, August 3, 2020. Funeral Services for Harry Mercer will be conducted Friday, August 7, 2020 at 2:00pm in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home with Rev. Bill Baker and Rev. Billy Sutton officiating.
