Mr. Harry R. Stevens, "Mr. Bulldog", age 73, passed away Thursday, February 27, 2014. Funeral Services will be conducted Monday, March 3, 2014 at 11AM in Northside Baptist Church with Dr. Jerry Pickard officiating. Interment will follow in Memory Hill Cemetery.

The family will be at Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville Sunday afternoon from 4-6PM to receive friends.

Mr. Stevens was a lifelong resident of Milledgeville. He was the son of the late Raymond K. Stevens and Francina Simpson Coarsey and was predeceased by his wife Martha Day Stevens and daughter Lynn F. Osburn. Mr. Stevens was a Veteran of the US Army, worked as a dispatcher for the Baldwin County Sherriff's Office, the Central State Hospital Police Department, and the Georgia State Patrol. He was a member of Northside Baptist Church and a huge supporter of the GMC Bulldogs.
