Helen Barret Geddy passed away on Monday, May 12, 2014 in Macon, Georgia. She was born on November 28, 1928, to William Pendleton Barret and Rosalie Francisco Barret in Richmond, Virginia. Her ancestors were early settlers of Jamestown, and her mother was a 4th generation direct descendant of Peter Francisco, a famous Virginian from the Revolutionary War. Helen was a member of the Jamestown Society, Society of the Descendants of Peter Francisco, The Daughters of the American Revolution, and The United Daughters of the Confederacy. She grew up in Richmond, but often visited the Horseshoe, the family farm, in Louisa, VA. She lived a full life in Virginia; Atlanta, GA; New York; Florida; St. Louis, MO; Columbus, OH; and Macon, GA, and she returned to visit family in Virginia often. She worked on and off throughout her life, staying busy and raising a family. She was a member of St. Francis Episcopal Church in Macon, GA. She is preceded in death by her husband, George Benjamin Geddy, Jr.; her brothers, William Pettus Barret and John Stuart Barret, Sr., both of Virginia; and her daughter, Lynne Tyler Kelly of Lawrenceville, GA.

She is survived by her sons George Benjamin Geddy III of Sedona, AZ and William Barret Geddy and his wife, Margaret, of Macon, GA, 6 grandchildren,

and 7 great grandchildren. According to her wishes, there will be a memorial held Saturday, May 31, 2014, 11:00 am, at St. Francis Episcopal Church in Macon, GA with services conducted by the Rev. Ben R. Wells. Her ashes will be interred in Williamsburg, VA with the Geddy family.
