Bogart – Sara Helen Dean Gordon passed away Oct.30, 2014, at the age of 91 at the GA War Veterans Home in Milledgeville, GA. Born in Farmington, GA, Oct. 2, 1923, second child to Arizona Turk Dean and Lonnie Carlton Dean, Sr., the family moved to Bogart in 1931 and began farming; moving into the house where the family still resides today.

Helen spent her childhood in Bogart, attended Bogart High School and after graduation in 1940, worked in the local pants factory sewing pants. She served during WWII in the Women's Army Air Corps as a radar technician stationed in Orlando, FL. After WWII, she lived and worked in Miami, FL, meeting her future husband, James J.
