Martha Helen Locke Sammons, age 88, of Milledgeville, passed away Friday, October 22, 2021.

Helen was born in Dublin, GA on August 16, 1933 to the late David Flournoy Locke and the late Mary Etta Edwards Locke.

Helen lived in Atlanta, Georgia prior to marrying Mark Sammons in 1956. After marrying, the couple moved to Dublin, Milledgeville, and Fayetteville before settling in Tennille, Georgia in 1977.
