Heliar Allen Crockett, Jr., age 78, of Lake Sinclair, passed away Sunday, October 6, 2019. 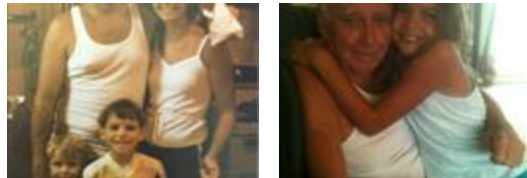

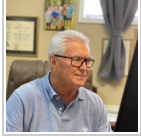
