Mr. Henry Cecil Power, 66, passed away on Thursday, March 17, 2022. A Funeral Service will be held on Monday, March 21, 2022 at 5 PM in the Williams Funeral Chapel in Milledgeville.

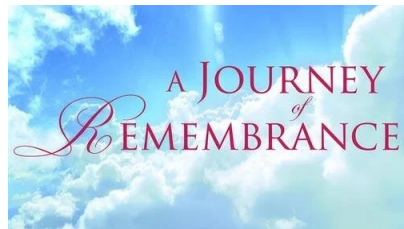
