Hilda was the daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. James Haynes of Cullman, Alabama. After graduating from Cullman High, Hilda received a BS from the School of Chemistry at the University of Alabama. She continued her education at the University Hospital earning a MT (ASCP) with her research being published in the "Journal of Bacteriology". During her long career with the State of Georgia, Hilda worked as Manager of Clinical Microbiology at Central State Hospital and served as Laboratory Director in both the Macon and Albany Public Health Laboratories. She also participated in professional development opportunities at the Center for Disease Control, Medical College of Georgia, Texas Department of Health, Florida Department of Health, and Georgia Department of Public Health.
