January 20, 1950 - August 27, 2021

Hugh Oscar Walton, age 71, of Gray, and formerly of Sparta, passed away Friday, August 27, 2021. Graveside services for Hugh Walton will be conducted on Wednesday, September 1, 2021 at 11:00 AM in the Sparta City Cemetery.

Hugh was born on January 20, 1950 in Greensboro, GA to the late James Thomas "Slim" Walton and the late Blanche Elizabeth Whitehead Walton. Hugh could never sit still. He was constantly working, spending time with his family, or busy with yardwork. He loved spending time with his kids and grandchildren, as they were his reason for living. He would often work multiple jobs, but always made it a point to come home, even if only long enough to tuck his children in at bedtime each night. Hugh was a member of the Sparta Baptist Church, and had served in the Army National Guard.
