March 12, 1918 - July 28, 2009

Mr. James Henry Merritt age 91 of Milledgeville passed away Wednesday, July 28, 2009. Funeral Services will be conducted Saturday, August 1, 2009 at 2 pm in New life Ministries Church of God on Log Cabin Rd. With Rev. John Milam and Rev. Randle Frashier officiating. Interment will follow in Baldwin Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends at the church from 1 o'clock until the funeral hour.

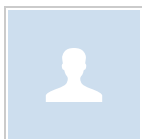

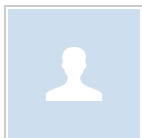
