January 9, 1937 - November 26, 2011

James T. (Jim) Lenahan, Sr, of East Lake Sinclair, Sparta, GA passed away on November 26, 2011 after battling cancer for many years.

He was born in Manhattan, NY, on January 9, 1937. Jim attended Pearl River High School in Pearl River, NY, and then joined the United States Air Force. He married Annette Sanacore on September 24, 1960. They lived in New York City, NY and Peachtree City, GA before moving to East Lake Sinclair in 2001. Last year they celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary in Milledgeville with scores of friends and family.

Jim enjoyed being involved with local politics and was a founding member of the LSHCPOA. A published author and artist, Jim founded the Turkey Club, and was, as recently as this current semester, taking classes at GC& SU, where he proudly proclaimed himself to be the "DOMOC".

Jim is survived by his wife, Annette, and their four children: James, Jr. (Jeannene) of Suwanee, GA; Michael (Sandra) of Loganville, GA; Charlene McLaughlin (Chris) of Senoia, GA; and Charles of Peachtree City, GA. He is also survived by 13 grandchildren.

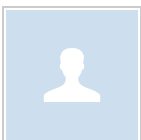

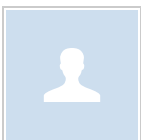
