Born in West Point, Georgia (a born and raised Georgia Girl). Got her BS degree in Physical Education from Georgia Southern, taught P.E. at Forest Park Middle School and Morrow Middle School. While at Morrow Middle School she coached basketball, swimming and also taught P.E. to special needs children.

She taught swimming at Forest Park Recreation Center and Coached at their basketball camp. She worked with Clayton County Special Olympics and worked at Rich's as a Security Guard and also worked at Crowe Marine in Eatonton.

She enjoyed traveling around Europe and the US and woodworking. She was a member of CCW (she was called "Queen of Clean" because she insisted keeping the kitchen clean at all times).

While living in Milledgeville she volunteered at Navicent Baldwin Hospital, every Wednesday and Friday for ten years, Food pantry for 5 years every Thursday, putting together Blessing Bags for children, Money counter at the church, office substitute at church when needed, and she made the wooden signs that are on both sides of the statue of Jesus at the church.

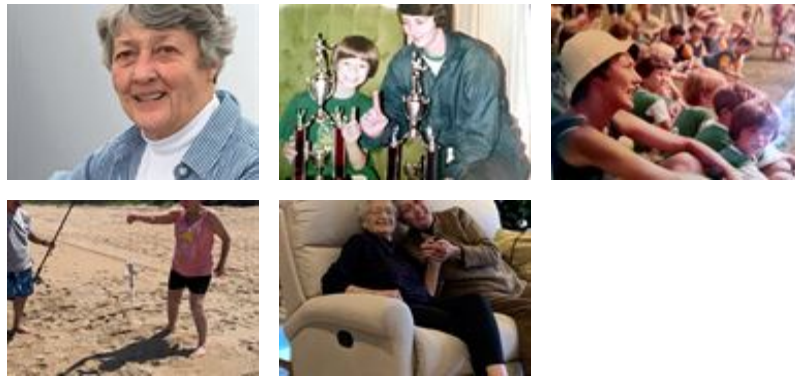
