Peggy Jean Yeager Allen, 76, of Eatonton, GA and formerly of Atlanta and Lithia Springs, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 2, 2009 after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Mrs. Allen was preceded in death by her parents, Durward and Pearl Yeager of Atlanta, a sister Pat Lane, of Eatonton, and a granddaughter, Mary Catherine Allen.
