



## Jerrold Wright

March 25, 1936 - August 24, 2018

Jerrold Morse Wright passed away on Friday, August 24, 2018. He was born on March 25, 1936 on Briar Patch Farms in Putnam County, Georgia. His mother was Olga Ansley Wright. He was raised by his beloved grandmother Anna Adams Ansley Hogan and beloved step-grandfather Uncle Jimmy Hogan.

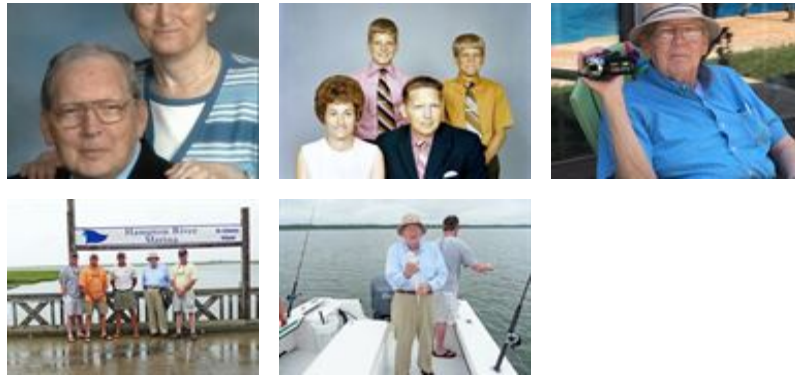
