Mr. Bush was the Director of Behavioral Medicine at Oconee Regional Medical Center and while previously employed by Central State hospital, he helped design the Culver Kidd Building. Also, he managed Physcian Practices in Georgia and South Carolina. He was a past board member of the Milledgeville Country Club, a life time member of the NRA and a member of First Baptist Church.
