The family will receive friends at the funeral home from 12 PM until the service hour.

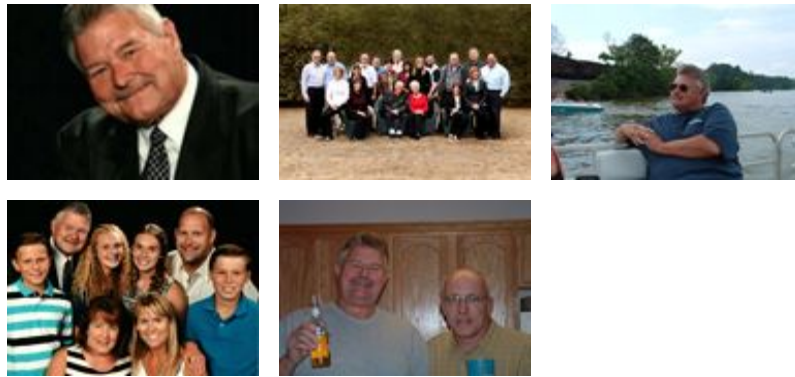

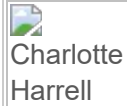
