Mr. James "Jim" Howell Seckinger, age 75, passed away Wednesday, November 12, 2014. Funeral services will be conducted in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville on Saturday, November 15, 2014 at 11 AM. Interment will follow in the Good Hope Baptist Church Cemetery in Naylor, GA at 4 PM.
