Jimmie Blackwell Webb passed away on July 22, 2009.

Funeral services will be at 1:30pm, Monday, July 27, 2009, at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church, Milledgeville, Ga. Burial will follow at the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Milledgeville, Ga.

Mrs. Webb, daughter of Mae P. Blackwell and the late J. B. Blackwell, was born in Godfrey, Georgia on August 23, 1939. Jimmie graduated from Mercer University with a degree in English and later earned a Masters Degree in Management from the University of Phoenix. She was employed by the Federal Government and held positions at the Pentagon, Fort Huachuca Military Base, Arizona, and Robins AFB. Jimmie retired, as a personnel specialist, from Civil Service in 1998.
