Mr. James "Jimmy" L. Harris, Sr., age 54, passed away on Saturday, February 27, 2016. A funeral service will be conducted on Wednesday, March 2, 2016 at 4 PM in Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church with Rev. Ralph Story officiating.

The family will receive friends on Tuesday, March 1 from 5-7pm at Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville.

Mr. Harris was a lifelong resident of Baldwin County and retired as an officer at the Central State Hospital Police Department. He was a member of Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church and was a licensed Baptist Minister. Mr. Harris was preceded in death by his parents, Clarence J.
