Mrs. Mauva Jo Henry, 87, of Milledgeville, died Tuesday, February 28, 2012.

She was born to the late Frank and Lora Floyd, August 30, 1924, in Ardmore, OK. She married the late Frank Henry in 1946, and they lived for over 20 years in Dallas, TX before relocating to Atlanta, GA in 1970.
