Mr. Babb passed away on Saturday, February 11, 2017. He was born in Wilkinson County to the late Clifford Babb and Nancy Bentley Babb. He was a founding member of the CB Radio Club, later the Civil Defense, not the Baldwin Fire Rescue. He was retired from Central State Hospital and was a member of Pathfinders and Mt.
