Joseph Benjamin Rogers, age 89, passed away Thursday, July 24, 2014. Funeral services will be conducted Saturday, July 26, 2014 at 3:00pm in the Williams Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Kevin Madden officiating. Burial will be on Tuesday at the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery.

The family will be at their home, 1025 Tignall Road in Washington, GA on Friday from 5:00pm to 7:00pm to receive friends.

Mr. Rogers was born on December 9, 1924 in Roundtree, GA near Quitman. He was the son of the late Joseph Alonzo and Laura Salina Freeman Rogers. Joe grew up in Rockmart, GA and Columbia, SC. He was drafted in WWII where he served in the Aleutian Islands for 18 months before returning to the states. He graduated from the University of South Carolina with a degree in Business Administration.
