Mr. Joel Chapman Lane, Jr., age 86, passed away Tuesday, December 20, 2011. Funeral Services will be private.

Mr. Lane was grew up in Bainbridge and had lived in Eatonton since his retirement from Westinghouse in 1985. He was the son of the late Joel Chapman Lane, Sr. and Agnes Sutlive Lane and was preceded in death by his wife Pat Yeager Lane. Mr. Lane was an Eagle Scout with the Boy Scouts of America.
