Mr. John Waylon Lindsey, a loving husband, father, grandfather, and great grandfather passed away Monday, April 30, 2012 at the Georgia War Veterans Home after a long battle with Alzheimer's Disease. Funeral Services will be conducted Thursday, May 3, 2012 in Williams Funeral Home Chapel at 10AM with Rev. Mike Cavin officiating. Interment will follow in the Georgia Veteran's Memorial Cemetery.
