John "Johnny" Sibley Weaver, Jr. age 64 passed away unexpectedly at his home on November 21, 2020.

Johnny is survived by his wife of 42 years, Charlette Boone Weaver, son John Sibley Weaver III "Trae" and a brother Bobby Weaver (Pam).

He is predeceased by his parents, John Sibley Weaver, Sr. and Patricia C. Weaver.

He was born in Augsburg, Germany on September 16, 1956. He graduated Georgia Military College High School Class of 1974. He graduated Georgia College with a Bachelor of Science Degree and Georgia Institute of Technology with a Bachelor Degree of Mechanical Engineering in 1980. He was one of two students in the first Dual Degree Program between Georgia College and Georgia Tech.

Upon graduation he went to work for Southern Company, specifically Georgia Power Plant Harlee Branch. He worked as a Senior Plant Engineer. In 1989 he got his Professional Engineer License, electrical and plumbing contractor license. He received the Engineer of the year award in 2011. He retired with 38 years of service.

He was a devoted husband and father.

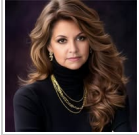

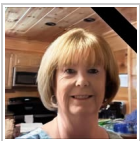
