Mr. Johnnie Clyde Jackson, 66, passed away on Sunday, August 12, 2018. Funeral services will be conducted at 12 PM on Wednesday, August 15, 2018 in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville with Rev. Hayward Bass officiating. Interment will follow at 2:30 in Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery.

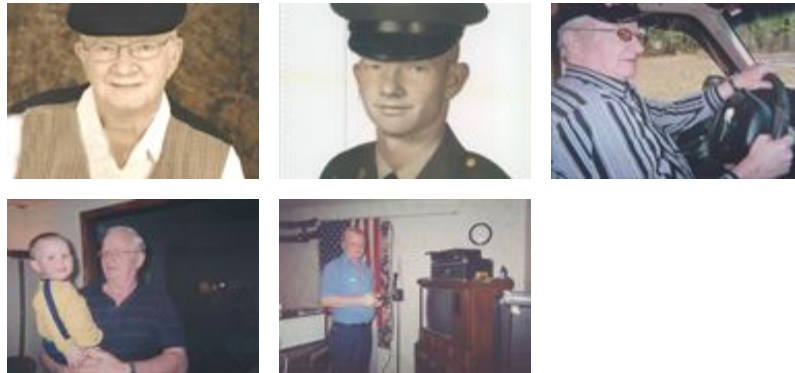

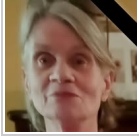
