Larry Donald McAdams, age 76, of Coopers, passed away Tuesday, April 29, 2025. Funeral services for Larry McAdams will be private.

Larry was born in Macon on August 4, 1948 to the late James Thomas "J.T." McAdams and the late Lucille Brady McAdams of McIntyre. In addition to his parents, Larry was also preceded in death by his wife, Eileen Babb McAdams of Coopers, by a brother, Tommy McAdams (Patsy) of Milledgeville, and by a sister, Shirley Allen (Martin) of McIntyre.

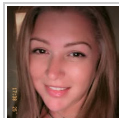
