Mr. Leonard Harry Queen, Sr., 75, passed away on Monday, September 23, 2019. Funeral services will be conducted at 3 PM on Monday, September 30, 2019 in the Chapel of Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville with Rev. Mac Enfinger officiating.

The family will receive friends at the funeral home from 2 PM until the service hour.

Dr. Queen was a native of Charleston, SC and had made his home in Sparta since 1992. He was the son of the late Horace Lorenzo and Margie Nell Edwards Queen and was preceded in death by his sisters, Juanita Wofford and Debra Gilham. Leonard received his Juris Doctorate degree and PhD from Walter F. George School of Law. 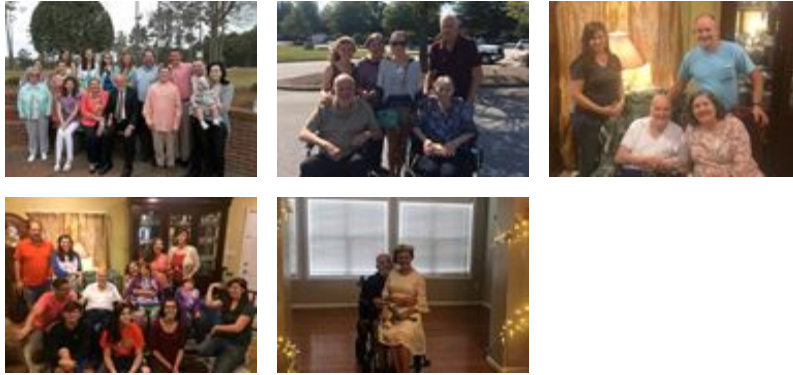
