Mr. Lloyd Aubrey Boatright, 89, passed away Tuesday, May 25, 2010 in a local hospital. Visitation will be Thursday, May 27, 2010 from 1:00 PM until 2:00 at Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville with services held Graveside at 3:00 PM at Zeta Cemetery in Tennille, Ga.

Mr. Boatright was a native of Tennille, living most of his life in Macon and Milledgeville. He was predeceased by his wife, Marie Boatright and his parents Harvey & Eliza Voss Boatright. He was a member of Bloomfield Baptist Church in Macon.

Mr. Boatright served in the U.S. Navy during World War II and also the Korean War. He was stationed aboard the U.S.S. Santee and was awarded the The Presidential Citation.
