



Dr. Louis Jacobs

February 16, 1933 - August 26, 2018

Louis J. Jacobs, M.D., 85, affectionately known to friends and family in earlier life as Jerry, in later life, Doc. He was born in Nashville, Berrien County, Georgia. His parents, Louis J. Jacobs, Sr. and Flossie J. Moore are both deceased. Doc was raised by his maternal grandparents, Alice and Harry Jackson in Nashville, Ga. He graduated valedictorian from Nashville High School in 1950.

Attending Mercer University in Macon, he graduated in 1954, Cum Laude. He attended the Medical College of Georgia from 1954 to 1958 receiving his M.D. degree with honors. After a general rotating internship at Medical School for a residency training in psychiatry, which he completed in 1962. He then completed one year adolescent Fellowship training there.

He served at Central State Hospital as a staff physician, unit director, and Director of a fully accredited independent Psychiatric Residency Training Program. After a couple of years practice of Forensic Psychiatry, he left SCH to enter private practice of psychiatry with offices in Macon, Dublin, and Milledgeville. After 4 years he became Medical Director in the Milledgeville Community Mental Health Program, and was there until he retired in 1998.

In 1980 he married Louise Moore, the love of his life; his stepdaughter, Elizabeth married his God-Son Roswell R. Howard Jr., both of whom survive

him; his brother in law and sister, Lee and Gail Runbaken of Decatur, Ga, several nieces and nephews also survive.

From 1964 until 1980, he and his good friend Roz Howard, Sr. had a racing business, Racing Associates Inc. They ran late model Sportsman cars in NASCAR and also on "outlaw" tracks in Georgia, South Carolina, Alabama, North Carolina and Tennessee with Roz Howard Jr. as the primary driver. Others also drove backup cars from time to time.

His life was devoted to helping and healing others. He is now with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, the truly great Healer!

Visitation will be at Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville on Wednesday from 5-7 PM. Funeral services will be Thursday at 11 AM in Bethel Baptist Church.

Interment will follow in Heritage Memorial Park.
