



## Margaret Jarvis - Boles

March 3, 1930 - October 14, 2006

Peggy Jarvis Boles, 76, formerly of Milledgeville, died Oct. 14 at her daughter's home in Macon. A funeral Mass will be celebrated Thursday at 11 a.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Macon where the family will hold visitation in the sanctuary beginning at 10 a.m. Graveside services will follow at 3:30 p.m. at Baldwin Memorial Gardens in Milledgeville. She was born Margaret Patricia Flanigan on March 3, 1930 in Brooklyn, N.Y. After beginning a family on Long Island and settling in St. James with her late husband, Tom Jarvis, they moved to Milledgeville with Grumman Aerospace in 1975. For the past 22 years, she has lived in Anderson, S.C., the home of her second husband, the late Clarence Boles Jr. A graduate of Fontbonne Hall Academy in Brooklyn, Peggy worked for New York Telephone and later served the priests at Sts. Philip & James rectory in St. James, N.Y. While in Georgia, she worked in Macon at Southern Bell, and in Milledgeville as a mail carrier for the U.S. Postal Service and customer service manager for J.C. Penney. Before her retirement in Anderson, she managed the pro shop of the Stone Creek Golf Club. Always the life of the party, Peggy loved people. From serving as a Boy Scout den mother to crafting costumes and cooking, she took great pleasure in doing for others.

She will be missed by her many friends and family including her children, Jay & Debra Jarvis of Rome and Matt & Liz (Jarvis) Fabian of Macon; grandchildren, James & John Jarvis and Faith Fabian.
