Marjorie (Margie) Jean Stephens Moughon was the youngest of Henry and Ethel Stephens' four daughters. She was born in Bainbridge, Georgia on February 11th, 1932, and was welcomed home one day shy of her eighty-third birthday.

She was the valedictorian of her senior class at Bainbridge High School, and after graduation attended Mercer University. While at Mercer, she was an active member of the Chi Omega sorority. She loved the Lord with all her heart, with her family at a close second. She loved people and showing them her love with hugs and smiles and food. As the mother of four, she immersed herself in their activities. Whether teaching a second-grade Sunday school class, serving as the pack leader for the Cub Scouts, or sitting on a wooden bleacher on a cold Friday night, she enjoyed spending time with her children. Her ten grandchildren and four great-grandchildren put an extra spark in her life. She would tell you that her family was her hobby.

When you think of Margie, the first thing that comes to mind is her laughter.

She had a very easy, contagious laugh. Her eyes would get wide behind her glasses, and her mouth would go to an O with a light "Ho ho!" escaping. The sound was the embodiment of delight, and she was quick to share it with everyone around her.

The second thing is that she was a prayer warrior. And I mean warrior. You wanted something done; you had her pray for it. This was a serious thing, that time and time again people saw work.

Margie's legacy will be her children: Jean Bloodworth and her husband Jerry from Gray, Jay and his wife, Nancy, from Clifton, Virginia, Steve and his wife, Delphia, from Gray, and Reid and his wife, Darla, from Macon. She had ten grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.

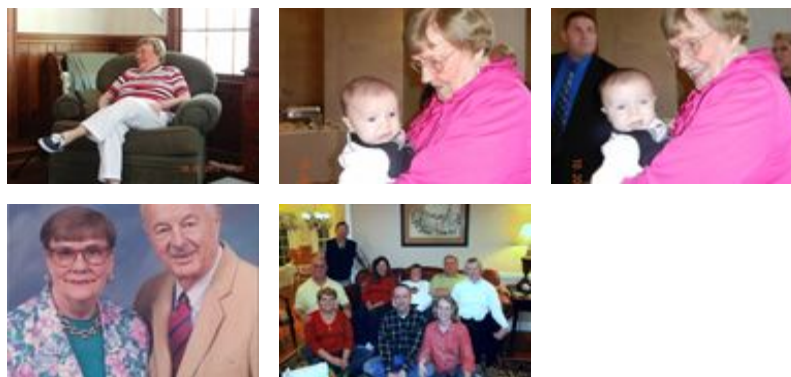
