Marion Gudrun Wittlinger Myers, age 64, of Lake Sinclair, passed away Sunday, January 1, 2023. 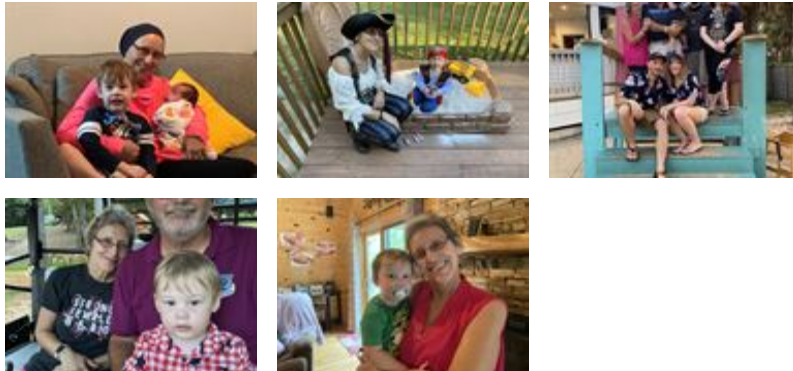

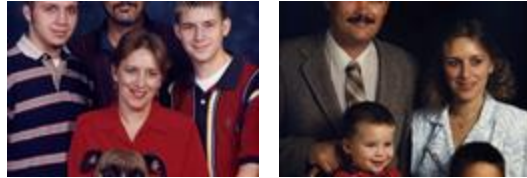
