Mr. Hodges passed away Wed., Jan.2, 2008 in Clayton, GA after a lengthy illness.

He had lived in Clayton for the past 2 years Born in Ft. Walton Beach, FL, Mark moved to Montgomery with his family in 1966 where he grew up and spent the majority of his life. He attended Flowers Elementary School, Goodwyn Junior High School and Jefferson Davis High School. He was an Eagle Scout in Troop Eleven in the Montgomery Boy Scouts and a standout athlete. He was a starting offensive lineman on Jefferson Davis' first state championship team, in 1978 and an all-state heavyweight wrestler.

Mr. Hodges was predeceased by his grandparents E. L. and Gertrude Willoughby Hodges and S. H. And Edith Wooten Napier, he was the son of the late Mary Napier Hodges.

He is survived by his father, Robert Hodges of Wetumpka, his sister Kay Hodges Wallace of Cornelia, GA, and his brother Michael Hodges of Manchester, NH, three nephews and two nieces.
