Mrs. Edna Maxine Shumate Allshouse, age 92, passed away Friday, July 4, 2014. Funeral Services will be held Friday, July 11, 2014 at 3:00 PM at the Covenant Presbyterian Church, Milledgeville, GA. with Rev. Andy Adams officiating. A graveside service will be held on Tuesday, July 15 at 12 PM at Southlawn Cemetery in South Bend, Indiana with Rev. David Miller officiating.
