Mr. Maynard D. Chambers passed away on Sunday, October 17, 2021. Funeral services will be conducted at 2 PM on Friday, October 22 in the Williams Funeral Home Chapel in Milledgeville. Interment will follow in Baldwin Memorial Gardens.

The family will receive friends at Williams Funeral Home in Milledgeville on Friday from 1 PM until 2 PM.

Mr. Chambers was a native of Deepstep and lived in Milledgeville for many years. He graduated from Mercer University with a dual degree in both Chemistry and Physics and was a very good business man.
