Michael D. Newton, 77, of Haddock, Ga., passed away Wednesday, January 4, 2023 at his residence in the presence of his beloved family. Visitation will be Monday, January 9, 2023 at Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville from 2:00-3:00 p.m. with the funeral service to follow at 3:00 with Rev. Larry Glover officiating. Interment will be at Baldwin Memorial Gardens Cemetery in Milledgeville.

Mr. Newton was born October 23, 1945 in Baldwin County where he was a lifelong resident, mostly in the Hardwick community. He was a postal clerk with the Hardwick Post Office for 38 years. He also worked at Georgia Military College in Milledgeville.

Mr. Newton was the son of the late Ralph P. Newton and Kathryn S. Newton of Baldwin County.

Mr. Newton enjoyed making fresh Boston butt BBQ, fishing, vacations with his family, attending local arts and crafts and music venues, and amateur radio. He often participated in "field day" weekends with MARC, the Milledgeville Amateur Radio Club.

He was a member and deacon of Emmanuel and Heartland Baptist Churches and Freedom Church of Milledgeville and Heartland Baptist Church in the Scottsboro community. He is survived by his wife of 50 years, Gayle C.

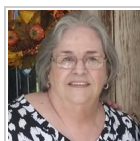

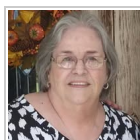

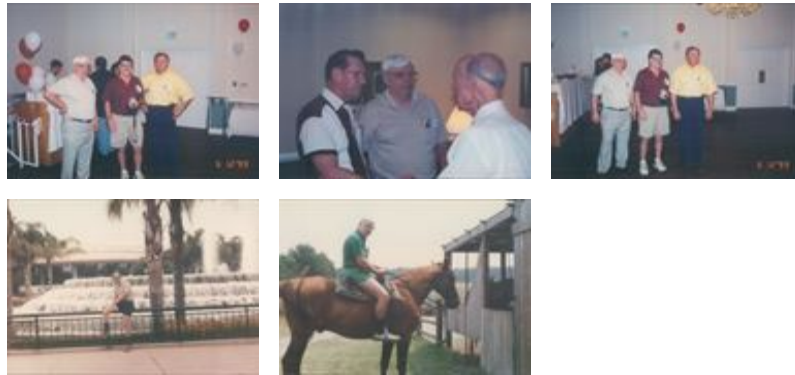
