



Mildred Burnette

March 11, 1920 - January 7, 2015

Mildred Newbern Burnette passed away Wednesday, January 7, 2015; at Lynn Haven Nursing Home, in Gray, Georgia. She was born March 11, 1920 in Sparks, Georgia to Dan Newbern and Mattie (Lockler) Newbern. Mildred was one of six children. She attended school in Cook County, Georgia.

Miss Mildred Newbern was married to Archie C. Burnette, May 11, 1940. They had four children; Barbara Stocker of Milledgeville, Georgia; Frank Burnette of Tallahassee, Florida; Sandra John of Eatonton, Georgia; and Liz Thompson of Poway, California.

Survivors include four children; twelve grand children, twenty-two great grand children, and fourteen great-great grand children.

Mrs. Burnette worked for seventeen years as dietary supervisor of Carlsbad By The Sea, in Carlsbad, California. After returning to Georgia in 1977, she continued to work in the dietary field as Supervisor with the Gwinnett County Hospital system in Gwinnett County, until she retired in 1986. At that time she moved with her husband to Milledgeville, Ga. She returned to work in the fall of 1986, working for Trapnel's shoe store, until the store closed; she then went to work for Belk's, and then Walmart. Retiring again in 2005 at the age of eighty-five.

Living in Milledgeville, Mrs. Burnette continued her life long passion for sewing; and was an active member of Northside Baptist Church, where she loved teaching Sunday school; as well as hosting Bible Studies in her home. She was instrumental in leading many people to Christ.

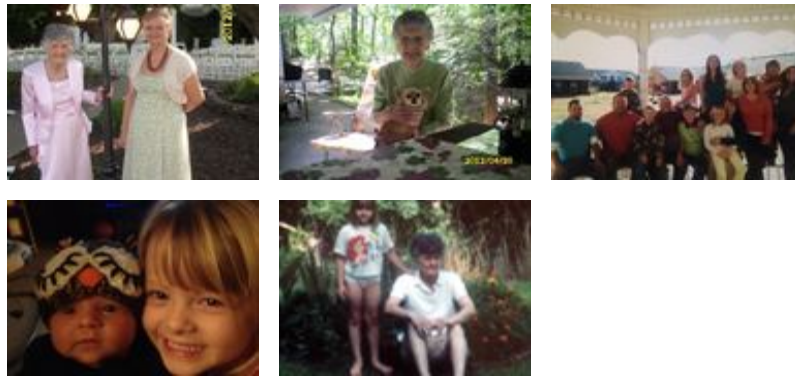
