“ It has been many years since I was able to see Nancy, but that changes none of the wonderful memories I have of this exceptional woman who helped raised me. I did not know her as Nancy Little, but I learned a great deal from Mema. She was my babysitter, my grandma, and my best friend for a very long time. I am thirty years old now, and I still tell my friends all about her and the things we used to get into. She was a wild woman, one of my favorite spitfires I've ever met. I loved the way she talked, and she kept me in line. Nancy also helped my mom through some very hard times, and she volunteered to watch my sister and I on weekends when all the other kids were gone. After we lost both our grandparents within the same few months, Nancy was the best stand-in a little girl could ask for, and she answered prayer our mom needed. She treated us like her own family, and for that we will forever be grateful.

Her house was our house, and her plums were my favorite fruit. We would walk around the pond together late in the afternoon and circle back to the plum trees. She'd pick em off and hand it straight to me - they were the best. When it was time to go inside, we used to make a line outside the bathroom for her to wash our hands, and I can still smell the soap she used. She fed us breakfast and lunch, sometimes even dinner. She saved my life one time when mom came to pick us up, I was bouncing around the kitchen with one of her candy peppermints in my mouth - She ALWAYS had peppermints - and I started choking. She snatched me up so fast and gave me the Heimlich maneuver, and then it popped right out. During the summertime, she gave us an ultimatum. She said you can either go play outside in the Georgia heat for 2 hours, or you can hang out inside the air conditioning and stay quiet to watch the soaps. So, a lot of times I would watch the soaps with her and go play outside later.

Mema was a big part of my life growing up, and until I moved farther away, I used to beg Mom - "Can we go see Mema today?" Even on her days off, I just wanted to go visit and sit with her for a bit. I will never forget her, and I just wanted to share such good times with

you all as well. She always has a place in my heart, and I am so thankful to have known her. I wish I could be there tomorrow to pay all of my many respects, but please know that I will be there in spirit. Rest Easy Sweet Lady ❤️

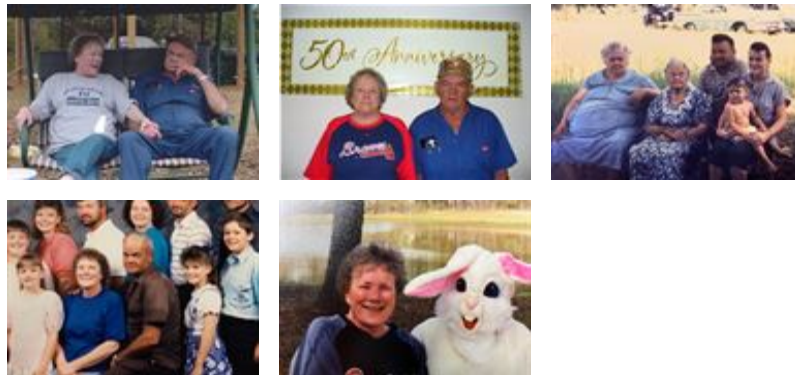

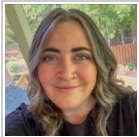
