



Nancy Pace

October 23, 1941 - March 29, 2014

Mrs. Nancy Lazenby Pace, age 72, passed away Saturday, March 29, 2014. Funeral Services will be conducted Wednesday, April 2, 2014 at 11AM in Haddock Baptist Church with Rev. Ron McClung and Rev. Ricky Varnell officiating. Interment will follow in the family cemetery located at 160 Oak Hill Farms Road, Gray, GA 31032.

The family will be at Williams Funeral Home of Milledgeville Tuesday Evening from 6-8PM to receive friends.

Mrs. Pace was a native of Atlanta and had made her home in Jones County for the last 66 years. She was the daughter of the late Vashti Venturia Arthur Lazenby and John Roy Lazenby, and she is preceded in death by her brother Robert Jenkins, and sister Brenda Jenkins Etheridge. Mrs. Pace made it her life goal to help others. A statement to her character, Mrs. Pace was named Jones County Citizen of the Year on two separate occasions. She was involved in many organizations including the Lions Club of Jones County, Beta Sigma Pi, and Keep Jones County Beautiful. Mrs. Pace was an active grandmother, helping with Little League Softball and reading in her grandchildren's elementary school classes. She was a member of Haddock Baptist Church and had attended Old Clinton United Methodist Church.

She is survived by her husband Mike Pace; son Michael Pace of California;

daughters Lisa (Mark) Smith of Gray, Michelle (Billy) Chambers of Gray, and Jan (Ken) Watson of Macon; grandchildren Steven (Emily) Pace, Will Chambers, Eli Watson, Jacob Watson, Tyler Smith and Wyatt Smith; great grandchildren Ansleigh and Ashlynn Williams and Hunter Pace; brothers Bob (Claudia) Lazenby, Walter Jenkins, and Donnie Jenkins; nieces Robyn (Wayne) Edy and Christina Munro; nephews Robert (Jennifer) Shane Lazenby and Daryl and Darrin Tate; and other nieces, nephews, and beloved family members.
