



Nancy Turnage Douglas

Nancy (Nance) Turnage Douglas, age 57, passed away Thursday, May 13, 2010.

A memorial service will be held Tuesday, May 18, 2010 at 2:00 PM in Magnolia Dining Room, Good Samaritan Center, Advent Christian Village, 10676 Marvin Jones Boulevard, Dowling Park, Florida, officiated by Pastor Jack Jones, Chaplain, GSC.

Nance grew up in Columbus, Georgia then attended Rabun Gap-Nacoochee School (RGNS) (Rabun Gap), Truett McConnell College (Cleveland), and Georgia College and State University (Milledgeville), making her home in Milledgeville and teaching in the Putnam County School System. She expressed her love of the arts by singing in an all-girls trio and RGNS

traveling choir, performing and singing in school plays and local theatre performances. She was an artist of acrylic, water colors, and pen and ink creations, and embraced life through photography that captured her love of travel, friends, and family. After retiring and the death of her beloved husband, she divided her time between Milledgeville and Florida, living near her mother and sister and her family.

Nance was the daughter of Virginia Beasley Page and the late Herman Leslie Turnage (Columbus) and step-daughter of the late Mattox B. Page (Dowling Park, Florida). She was preceded in death by her husband Conrad Douglas (Milledgeville).
