and Mike (& Merlene) Wolfe of Oklahoma ; 8 grandchildren ; 25 great grandchildren ; and 8 great great grandchildren

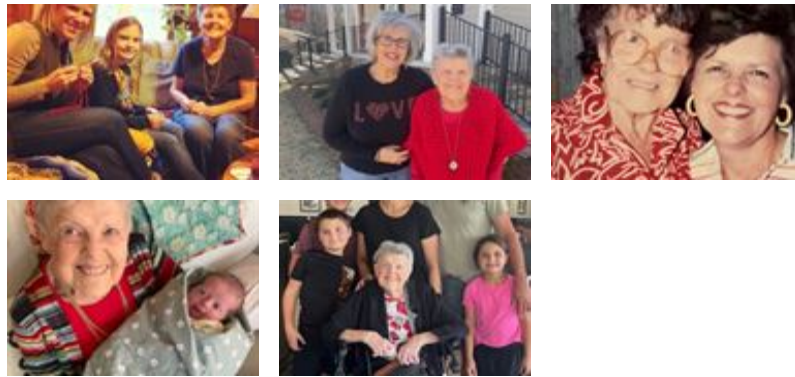
