Patricia Lee Smith Byrd, Age 80, passed away, Wednesday, January 17, 2018 after a brief illness. She was born July 22, 1937, in Mansfield, Georgia, to the late William Ernest and Mary Shinholster Smith. Pat moved to Macon and there met the love of her life and husband of 62 years, the late Bobby Shell Byrd. They were married June 1, 1955.

Mrs. Byrd attended Norman College where she graduated with honors in 1963. She continued her education at Mercer University graduating in 1965 with a BA in English. Though her life was devoted to her children, Patricia completed a Master's Degree in Psychology, 1985, from Georgia College and State University. She was a member of First Baptist Church of Milledgeville, several book clubs, and dedicated to Animal Rescue.
