Patricia Epps Horton, age 81, of Milledgeville, passed away Wednesday, February 26, 2025. 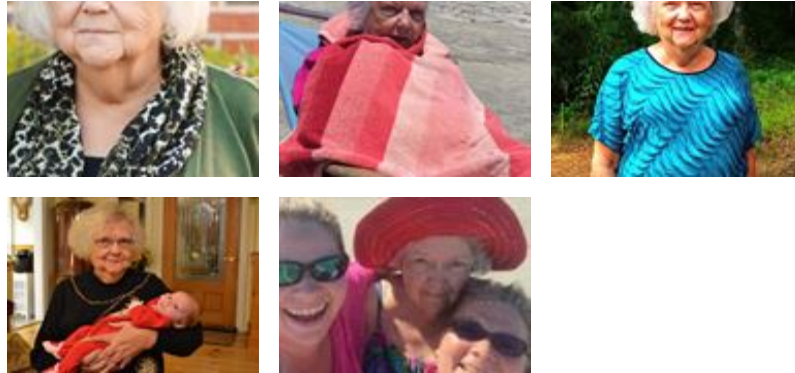
